Financial Policies

Old Mountain Health Center [OMHC] believes in providing affordable health care. Following this principle OMHC utilizes a donation style sliding scale fee system where the patient decides how much they can afford to pay for each treatment within a specific range set by OMHC. The scales for each type of treatment are:

- Private Acupuncture Treatment.....\$40 - \$80
- Acupuncture & 30 mins Tui Na [Massage].....\$60 - \$100
- Group Acupuncture Treatment.....\$15 - \$35
- Herbal Consultation.....\$10 - \$15*
- Herbal Patent Medicines.....\$8
- Chinese Massage [Tui Na] 30 mins.....\$20 - \$40**
- Chinese Massage [Tui Na] 60 mins.....\$40 - \$80**

We ask that patients consider what they can afford without putting themselves in any financial trouble while respecting the value of both the treatments being offered and their own health.

All payments are due at the time services are rendered. Payments are deposited in a drop box at the front desk of the clinic. It is the patients responsibility to fill out the pay slip and put the appropriate payment with the pay slip in an envelope in the drop box. Receipts will be provided for patients who desire them either by mail or at the time of the next appointment.

If for some reason payment is not received by OMHC at the time of service than an invoice will be mailed to the patient's address on file. If payment is not received within 7 days then no further treatments will be scheduled or provided and interest will begin accruing at a rate of 10%.

Currently, OMHC does not bill insurance for its treatments. However, OMHC will provided a receipt with all the proper information so the patient can submit it for reimbursement from their insurance company if they so desire. It is the patients responsibility to determine if their insurance company pays for acupuncture treatments.

OMHC understands that it is not always possible to keep scheduled appointments, however, we ask that patients act responsibly try their best to keep them. If for some reason a patient cannot make it to an appointment OMHC asks that patients give 24 hour notice of a cancellation so as not to deprive other patients of the opportunity to receive treatment. If more than two appointments are missed or canceled with less than 24 hour notice, patients will be billed for the third and all subsequent missed appointments.
